This century-old sea captain's house, originally built by Captain Thomas Townsend, has been the family residence of Parker, the innkeeper, for the past 40 years. Eight generations of Parker's family have fished from the sea and, like Captain Townsend, he has an ancestor who fought in the second siege of Louisbourg.



Most of our beautifully decorated guest rooms overlook historic Louisbourg Harbour. Each room has a queen bed, private bath, hardwood floors, high ceilings and homey furnishings. Our guest balcony, overlooking the water, affords an excellent view of the harbour, from the nearby fishing boats and wharves out to the islands, Fortress and ocean beyond.



Just off Main Street, Louisbourg Harbour Inn is situated on the harbour next to a working fishing wharf and the Louisbourg Playhouse, where traditional Island music and dance are performed every evening from late June to mid-October. We are only a mile from the Fortress of Louisbourg Visitor Centre.
